Our "Green" Action Plan

We are striving to achieve more environmentally friendly methods, systems, ethos and habits to try and protect all the livestock, wildlife, flora and fauna in our care. We have identified that many things we do are helping to sustain our environment but we can of course always do more. In order to develop this further we have created an Action Plan which identifies a possible "need" and the resulting action required to satisfy that need with an outline of the timeline we believe we can achieve the action within.

Below are several actions which we believe are achievable, sustainable and within our power to do:

Cleaning Products	Replace all cleaning products, toilet tissue, etc., with "green" products sourced locally to avoid adding "miles" to the cost of the products.	Jacky	May 2010
Insulation	Check all loft insulation is meeting current guidelines and replace where necessary	Jacky	October 2010
Composting	Provide vegetable waste composting bin for guests to use.	Jacky	February 2010
Bird Boxes	Situate more bird boxes in and around the "nature reserve" alongside our section of the stream	Jacky	November 2010
Bat & Owl Boxes	Locate bat/owl boxes in suitable areas around the farmyard and immediate area	Jacky / Richard	November 2010
Glazing	Install double glazing as and when windows require replacement	Jacky / Richard	2020 (estimated)
